Be sure to enter the same email you used when purchasing the Hum device. Then create your account.



Install Your Device and Speaker

IMPORTANT

Make sure your vehicle is turned off and verify you have good network coverage. Plug the OBD Reader into the OBD-II port.



TIP

The OBD-II port is usually located under the driver's side dash. For help locating your OBD-II port, visit hum.com/port.

Linking Your Hum Account

- 1 Open the Hum App, click the side menu and select the Google Assistant prompt.
- 2 Select "Hum actions setup"
- 3 **Link to the Google Assistant:**
The Hum app will redirect you to the Google Assistant app on your phone to begin linking your account. Follow the directions within the Google Assistant app.
- 4 **Link the Google Assistant to Hum:**
After completing steps within the Google Assistant App, you will be directed back to the Hum app to finish linking your accounts.

Verify

- 1 Sign back into your Hum account through the Hum app.
- 2 Click, "allow access" and follow the on screen steps to finalize setup
