




Download the Hum App

Go to the App Store or Google Play™ to download the Hum App. Then create your account

IMPORTANT

Be sure to enter the same email you used when purchasing the Hum device.





Install Your Device and Speaker

IMPORTANT

Make sure your vehicle is turned off and verify you have good network coverage.

Plug the OBD Reader into the OBD-II port. Charge the Speaker then clip it to your visor. (We recommend charging your Speaker for at least 20 minutes.)



TIP


The OBD-II port is usually located under the driver's side dash. For help locating your OBD-II port, visit hum.com/port.

Start Driving and Enjoying Hum


Take a few trips. (Drive at least 6 minutes or longer.)

We will send you a mobile notification once you turn off your vehicle to let you know that all your Hum features are active.



Learn about your Hum Speaker

The speaker allows you to quickly connect to a trained Emergency Assistance agent in the event of a collision, or to Customer Service and other important Hum services.



A Hands-Free Calling On/Off Switch
Switch "On" to enable Bluetooth

B Customer Service Icon
Tap, then push the Call Button to connect with a Hum specialist, request roadside assistance or to reach the Mechanics Hotline.

C NumberShare Icon
Tap, select your contact, then press the Call Button.

D Emergency Assistance Icon
Tap, then push the Call Button for emergency assistance.

E Mute Button
Press to mute the microphone during a call.


F Volume Buttons +/-
Control the speaker volume or mute incoming call ringer.

G Call Button
 Press to place an outgoing call.
 Press to end an active call.

H LED Indicator Ring
 Bluetooth* paired
 Low battery
 Microphone muted
 Battery fully charged
 Battery 50% charged


Connect to Hum Wi-fi

- 1 Turn on vehicle ignition.
- 2 Enable Wi-fi on the smartphone, laptop, tablet, or other device you want to connect.
- 3 Select your Hum^x network (SSID).
- 4 Enter your Hum^x password to connect.



Note Your temporary Hum^x network name (SSID) and password (PW) are located on the back of your Hum^x Speaker.

Set up NumberShare



- 1 Sign into your My Verizon account, go to Manage Connected Devices to share your phone number with the Hum^x System.
- 2 Open the Hum App and from the menu, select NumberShare and add up to three Hum Contacts.
- 3 To make a call, tap the NumberShare icon. Use the arrows to select one of your Hum contacts and press the Call button.

Note Add up to three contacts to your Hum^x Speaker for NumberShare. You can update your Hum Contacts at any time.

Pair your phone to the Hum Speaker

- 1 Turn on your vehicle's ignition, then move the Hands-Free On/Off Switch to the "On" position.
- 2 Press and hold the Call Button for five seconds.
- 3 Enable Bluetooth* on your phone, then select "Hum." If prompted for a PIN, enter 0000.

Important:

Make sure your Hum Speaker is charged.

To save time, download the Google Assistant App from the Apple App Store/ Google Play Store if you do not already have it, and sign into your Google Account.

Make sure you are in your vehicle when performing the Hum^x Speaker Setup.

If your device has the latest Firmware you will see the Google Assistant link in the Side Menu. If you do not see the Google Assistant link:

- It may take a few drives to update your device to the latest Firmware.
- Also make sure you have the most current version of the Hum App installed.

Have your Google Account/Gmail Username and Password ready before proceeding with Account Linking.

Hum^x Devices purchased before June 2018 should proceed directly to the Account Linking section.

Using Google Assistant on your Hum^x Speaker will disable your hands-free connection with your phone. Once Google Assistant is set up you will have the ability to toggle between the two features.

Hum^x Speaker Set Up*

- 1 Open Hum App and select 'Google Assistant' from the Side Menu.
- 2 Once on the Google Assistant landing page select 'Begin Set Up'.
- 3 Follow the Step by Step instructions provided to Set Up Google Assistant on your Hum^x Device.

*For device purchases made before June 20, 2021

- 4 Once your Hum^x Speaker is set up, you will then have the ability to Link Your Hum Account to your Google Account.

Note

This can be done during setup, or you can do it at a later time by accessing ‘Hum Actions Setup’ from the Google Assistant feature in the Hum Side Menu. If performing this at the end of the Hum^x Speaker set up process, proceed to Step 3 of the Linking Your Hum Account section.

Linking Your Hum Account

- 1 Open Hum App and select ‘Google Assistant’ from the Side Menu.
- 2 Select ‘Hum Actions Setup’
- 3 Select ‘Sign In’ button to sign into your Google Account

Note

You may already be signed into your Google Account, if so the ‘Sign In’ button will not appear, and the screen will display the signed in Google Account account.

- 4 Once signed in, click the ‘Link’ text and follow the prompts to sign into your Hum Account.
 - a. If you are linked the text will change to ‘Unlink’.
- 5 Once Linked click the ‘Complete Setup’ Button on the bottom of the screen to be returned to Hum, and Account is now linked.

Verify

Using your Google Assistant enabled device try asking Google a Hum related question such as “Ask Hum, how much gas do I have left?”

Note

To ask Hum related questions start question with “Ask Hum” or “Ask Verizon Hum”. See ‘Using Google Assistant’ in the Google Assistant Side Menu in the Hum app for more Vehicle related questions you can ask Google.
